He was honoured by the Friends of the Law Faculty Association (Freundeskreis Rechtswissenschaft e.V., Münster) for his achievements in the First State Exam and was awarded the Martin Domke Award for the Best Individual Oralist in the Willem C. Vis International Commercial Arbitration in Vienna.
